



ADMISSION CRITERIA

We seek purposeful well-balanced professionals who are serious scholars and committed practitioners. Master's students ordinarily have a 3.0 or higher GPA, strong references, research interests, and goals that fit the program's focus. Doctoral students have a high Master's GPA, focused research interests, successful experience in practice, and a compelling vision of their scholarly interests. We also seek students who demonstrate a commitment to diversity, equity, and justice in higher education.

- Use your personal statement to show us more than your résumé. We appreciate reflection on meaningful personal or professional/academic experiences (something that expanded your intellectual curiosity or has informed the person you are today, including social identities such as race, class, gender, or sexual orientation, to name a few). Master's personal statements should be 3-4 pages double spaced, and Ph.D. statements should be 4-5 pages.
